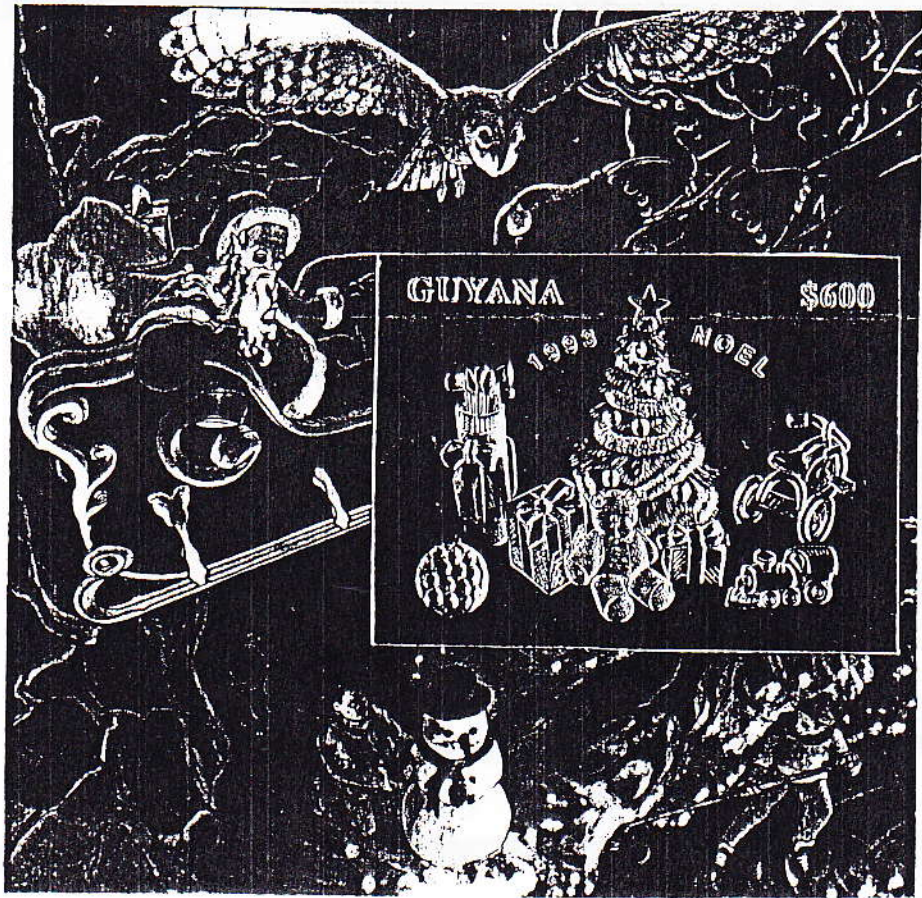

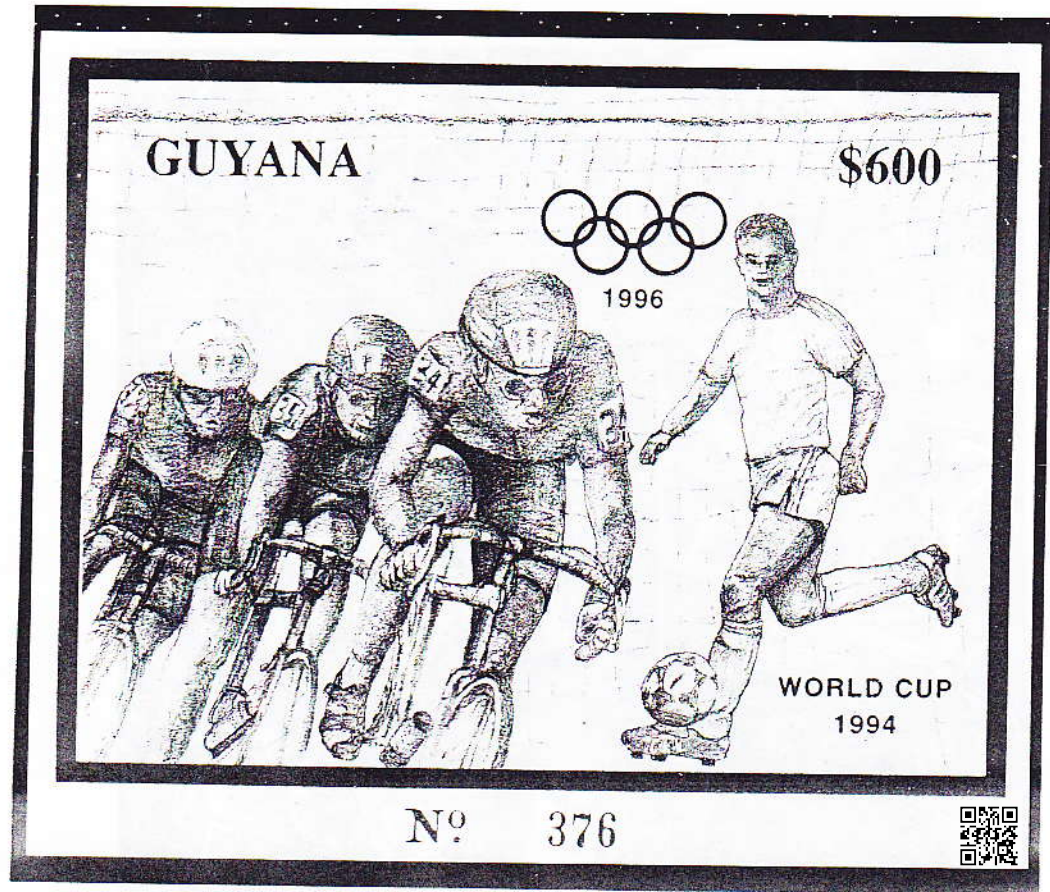
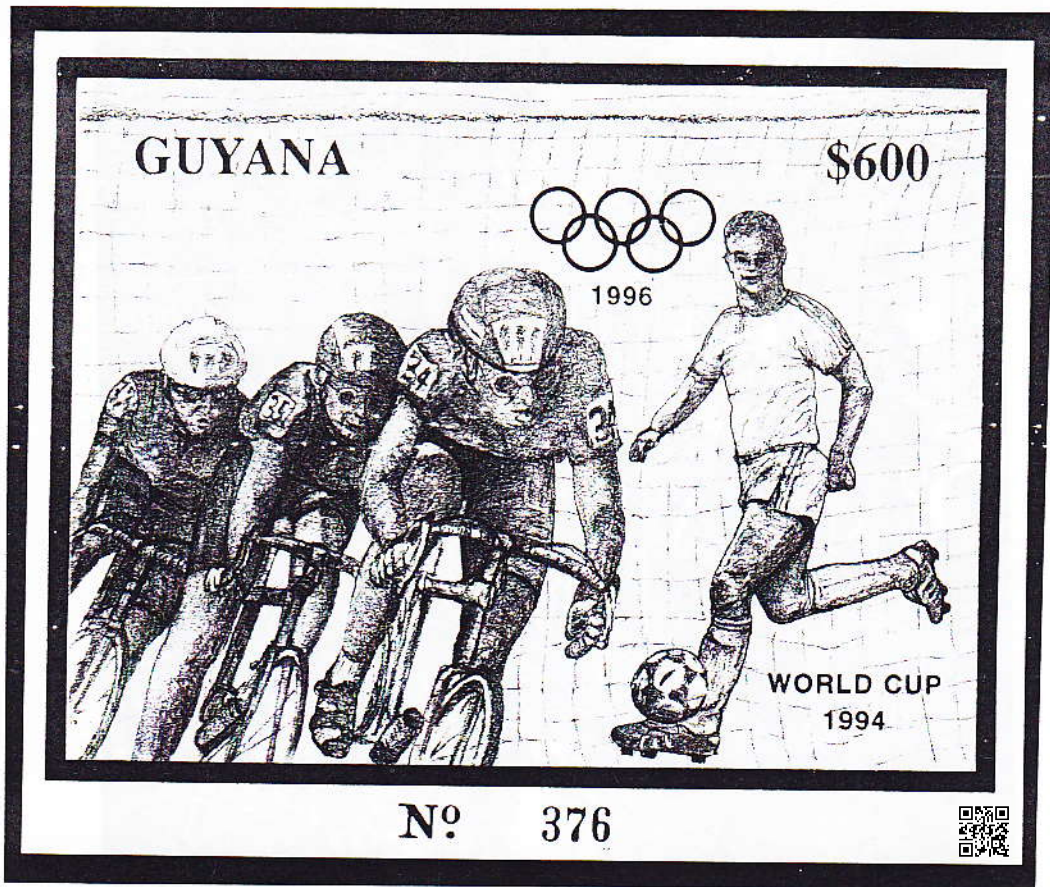

There is news on the local stamp area. Maasland is going to issue the definitive stamps overprinted with 45ct.

The reason is that the old stock is going to be used for the christmasperiod, when the rating is 45 ct pro card or letter.

The overprint is in black on the silverprinted stamps. All the leftover sheets are overprinted so there is 45c on 50c, 45c on 55c and 2x 45c on 60c (with and without text at bottom). The sheets are in eight colours.

A complete set has the face value of f 144,-.

Please make an announcement in BSC-magazine on this.

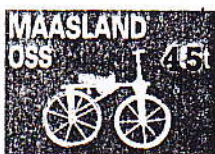
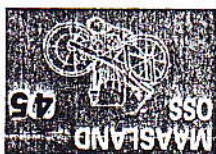

The World Championship Bicycle Races

from Inge Johansen and Bertil Wademan

There were nine official cancellations used during the World Championship Bicycle races this year. Each is symbolic and has been described by Bertil Wademan as follows:

1. The famous velodrome in Hamar, formed as a Viking ship. Place of the opening of the 1993 World Championships.
2. A symbolic bicycle track.
3. Track racing.
4. Road racing (Team competition)
5. "Sopus," the official mascot of the competitions.
6. The Union Cycliste Internationale congress.
7. The Bicycle World Championships - 100 years
8. Road racing (single track)
9. End of the competitions. A racing cyclist in front of the Oslo town hall.

Bicycles and stamps

Bicycles have a long history. They are said to date back to 1817, but in fact Leonardo da Vinci made a sketch that was incredibly like a bicycle as early as the 15th century. It is Karl de Drais de Sauerbrun, however, along with other great names like Macmillan and Michaux, who has been given the credit for the invention of the bicycle.

The first bicycle had only two eight-spoke wheels connected by a crossbar and the seated rider simply propelled himself along with his feet. One design of bicycle after the other appeared as time went on. The one we know best is probably the "penny-farthing", with its large front wheel. For a long time, bicycles were operated by pedals connected directly to the wheel. Then came the chain. But there were no hub brakes at that time. These did not appear until 1895. The pneumatic tyre was invented in 1888 and with this the bicycle became common property.

By that time, cycling competitions had also started, both with penny farthings and other velocipedes. The racing gear was a tremendous innovation in this context. It was now possible for the racing cyclist to choose the transmission that suited him best. It was a bit impractical to begin with, of course. When a competitor came to a steep hill, he had to dismount and turn the wheel, because there was a drive on each side. In 1909 the dérailleur gear saw the light of day in France. This was the predecessor of the gear we know today. Very thin racing tyres also made their debut at that time.

Competitions had an early start in Norway, too. The modern velodromes were still a long way off, so the competitions were held on gravel. Norway has long traditions in this sport. The first world championship was a Norwegian called Wilhelm Tryggv. He won the title in 1894.

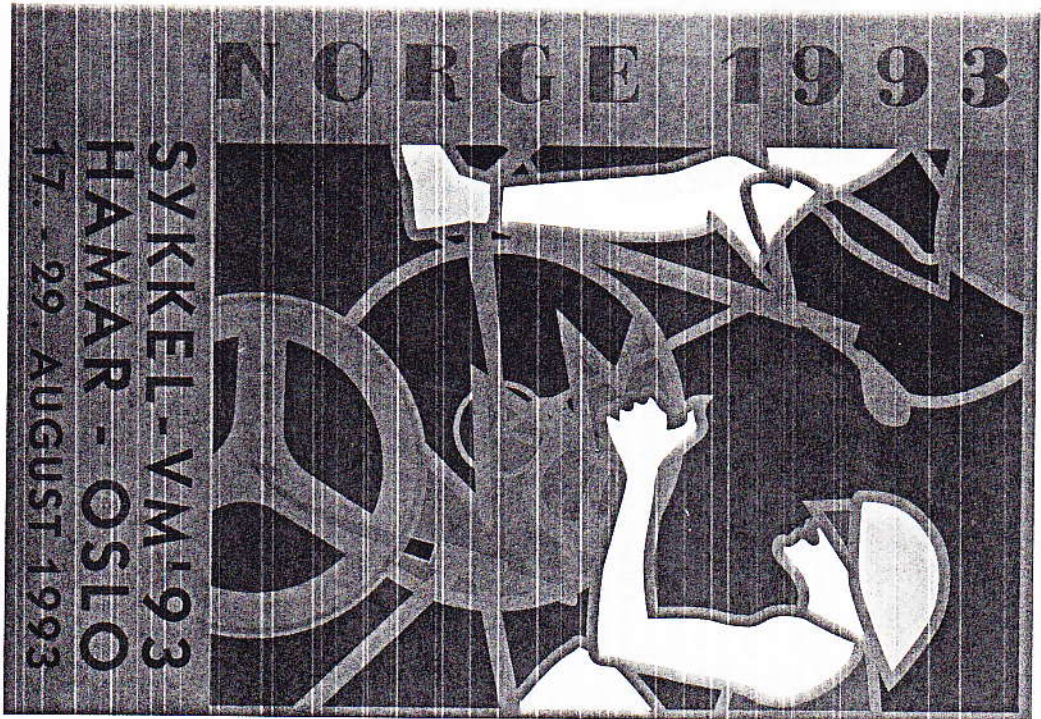

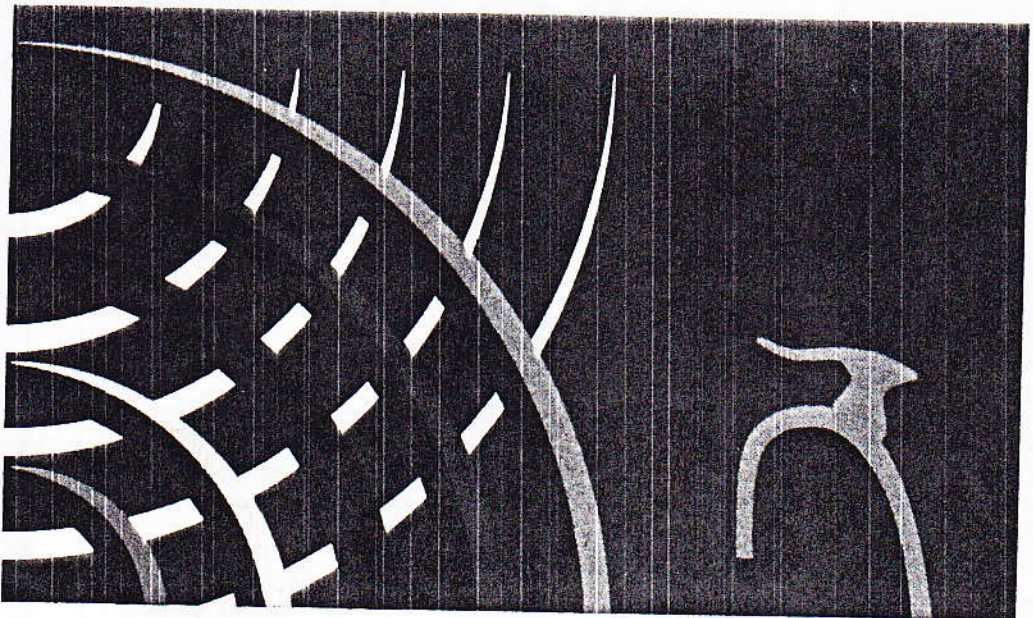

The 73 "Volta" a Cyclista a Catalunya took place September 9 through 15, 1993. This race takes place in the mountainous area covering that portion of the interior of Spain which surrounds Barcelona. Participation is usually divided about equally between the better riders from Spain and riders from the rest of the world.

There has never been a stamp issued for this race, however, as with most other races a large number of items of interest to collectors have been created, including many special cancellations, covers, postcards, labels, literature, and pins. Photos of some of the more recent follow.
