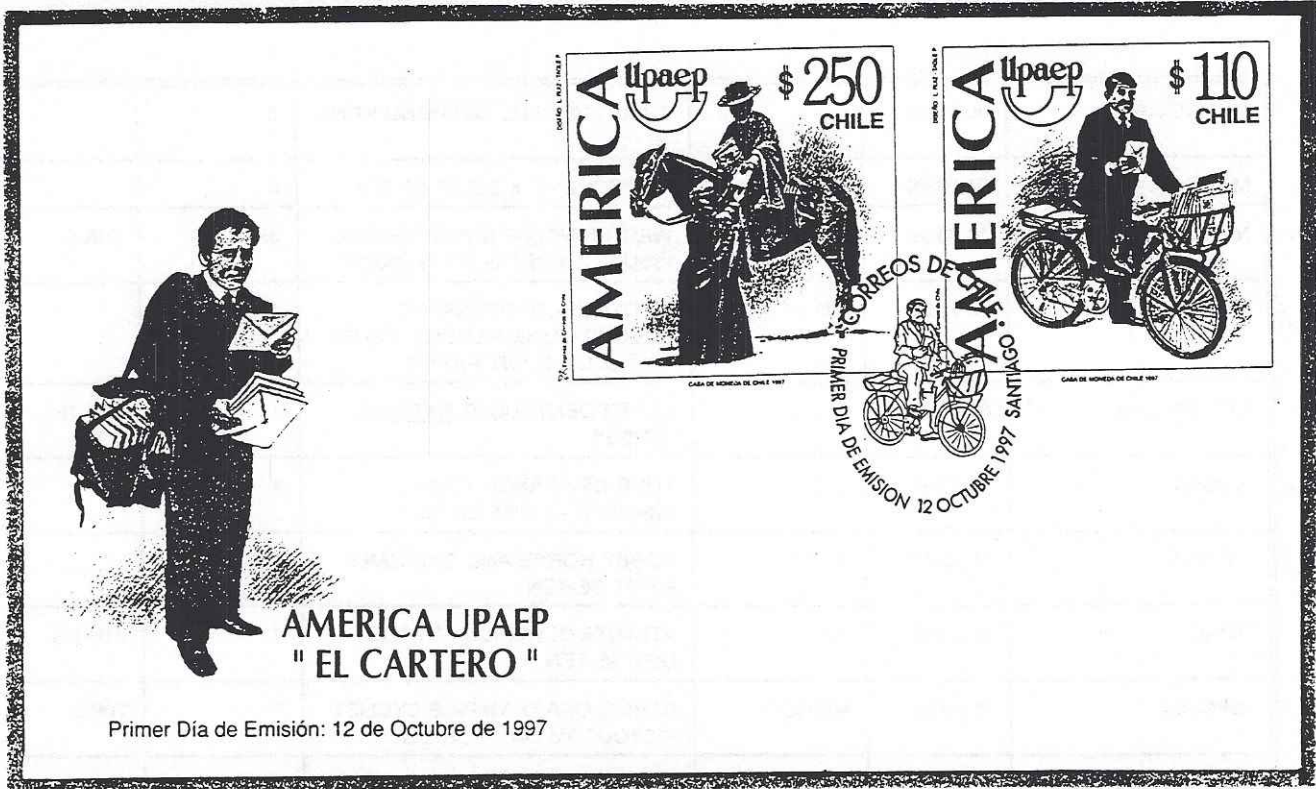

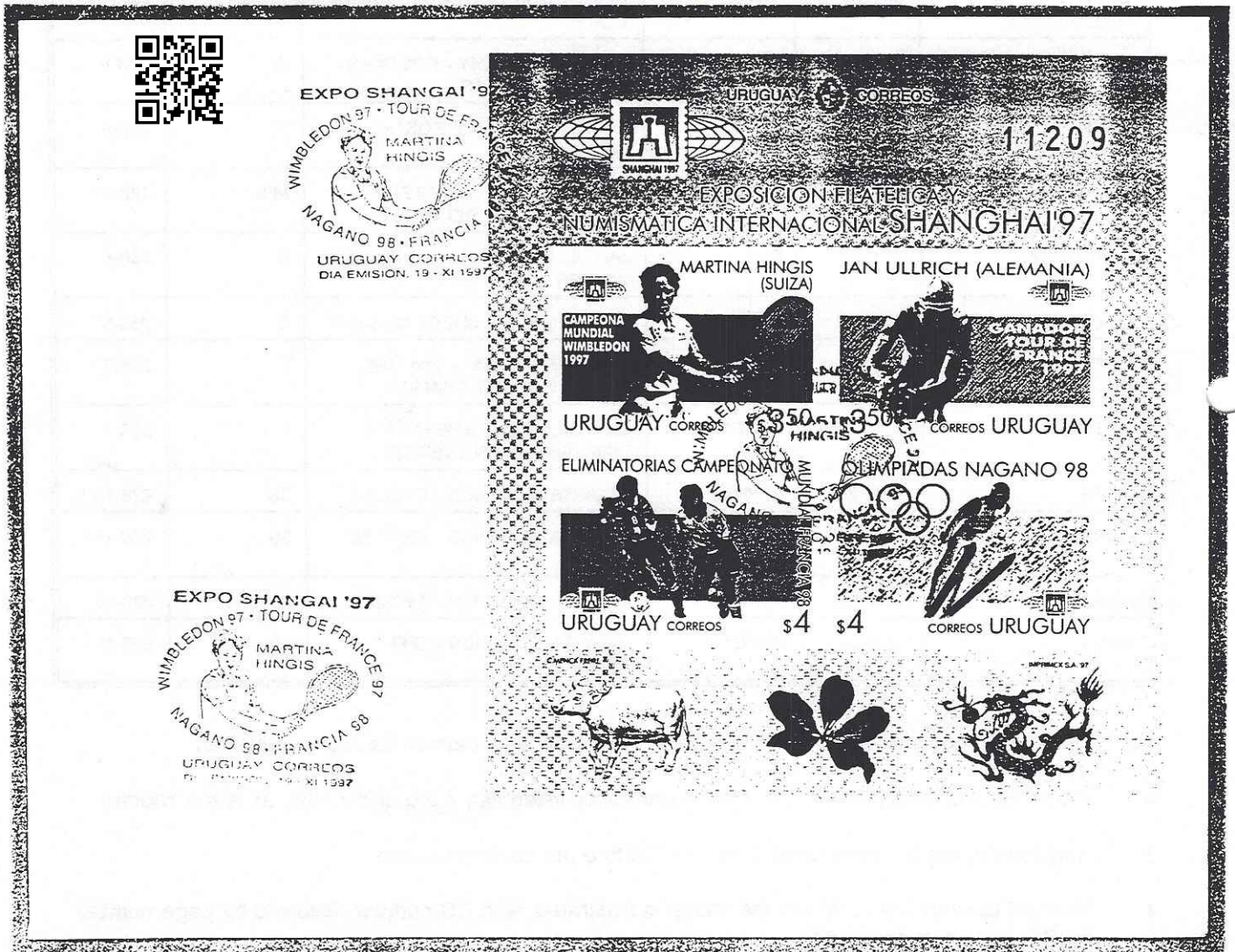

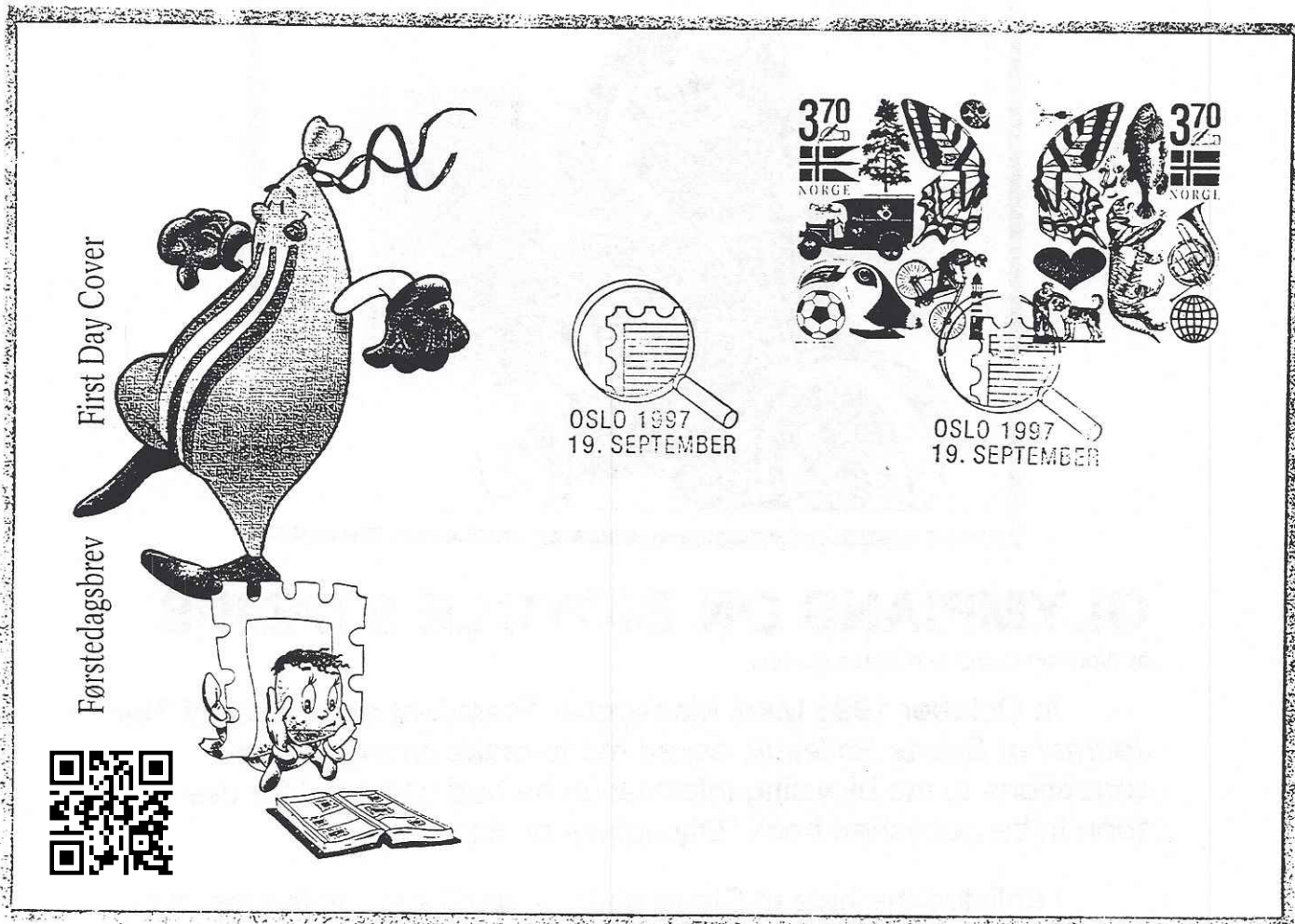

OFFICIAL FIRST DAY COVER

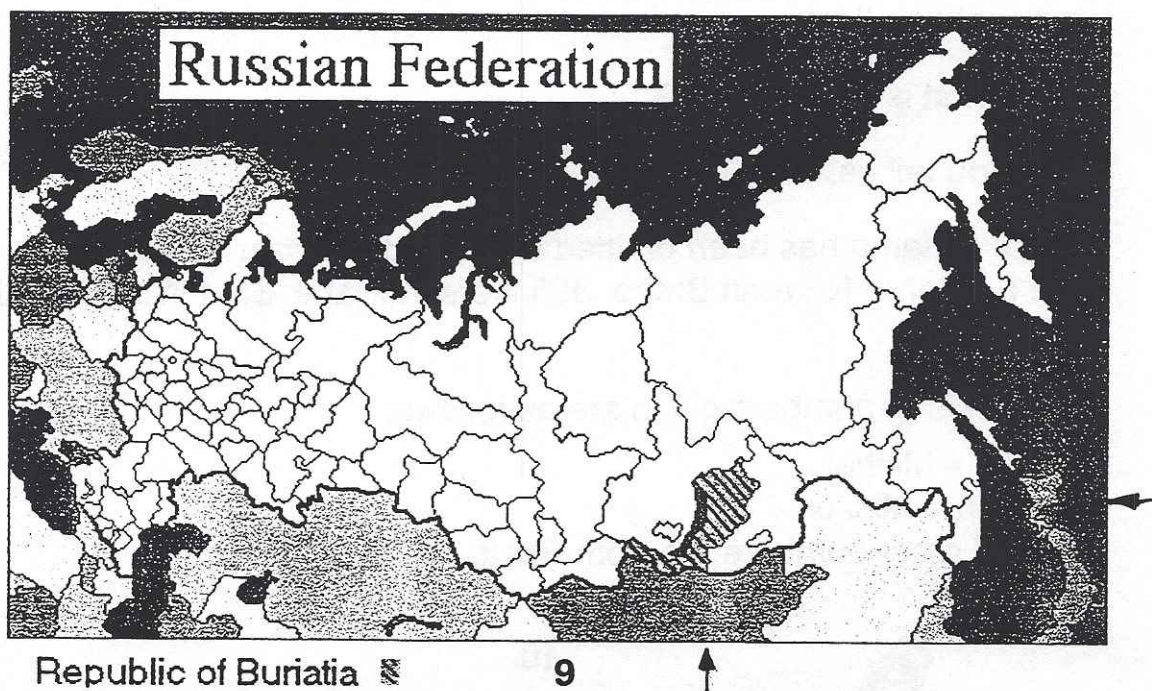




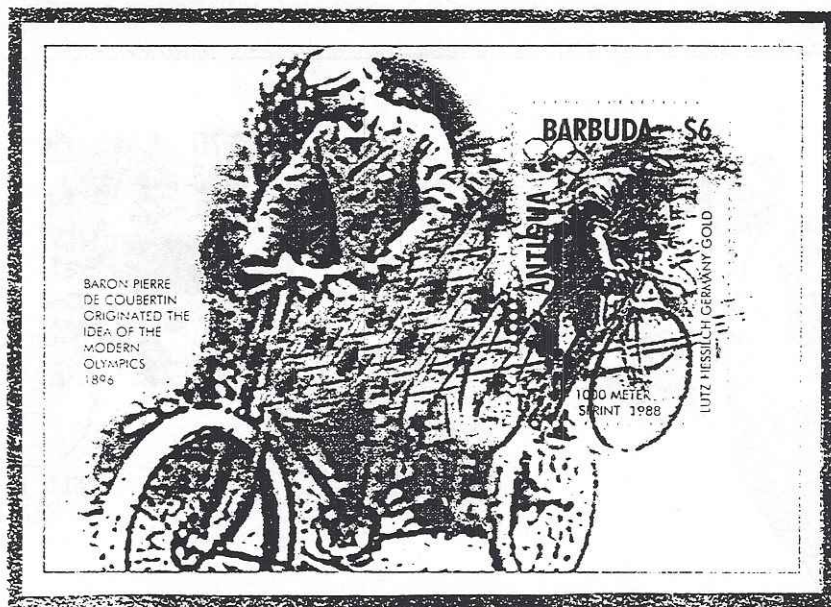
## REPUBLIC OF BURIATIA

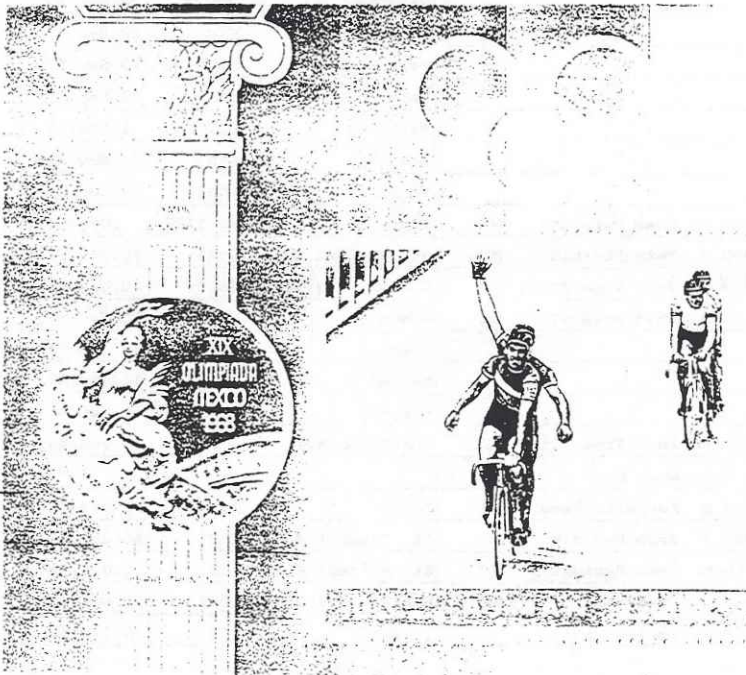

## Our Duty to Posterity

"The more uncommon the material the more important it becomes that some information regarding the location of copies should be given" – Roy Stokes, *The Function of Bibliography* (1969)

In the November 1997 issue of *Bicycle Stamps*, both Douglas Marchant (by implication) and Ron Sant referred to the magazine providing BSC members over the years with great detail about many subjects. Together with its predecessor, *Spoken Word*, and the independent *Cycle Clips*, it certainly does contain much information of lasting value to philatelists and cycle-historians, often provided after a lot of hard work. But how can new members access the data – and will future generations be able to benefit? At present an important article (say on the early German locals or the Swiss military stamps) is useful only to the readers of the particular issue in which it appears and is then all but lost to posterity.

For a start, how many complete sets of the three magazines exist? When I joined the club in 1992 I was happy to pay 10p a page for photocopies of back numbers and was lucky in that two British members were willing to supply these. Today a photocopying and postage bill for all back issues would easily top £100. I suspect that many original copies have been thrown away by ex-members who lost interest, or will be discarded when people die and their heirs have no idea what to do with the old magazines. (Let us hope these heirs have clear guidance on what to do with all those cycling stamps – not the easiest items for a non-philatelist to sell.) I suspect also that limited BSC finances have never permitted copies of the magazine to be donated to specialist philatelic libraries.

Indeed, are there complete sets of *Spoken Word* and *Bicycle Stamps* belonging to the Club rather than to individuals? If not, I think we should try to remedy the omission, assembling the freshest and most original sets possible, preferably in more than one part of the world. (Many of my own copies would not satisfactorily photocopy again.)

A couple of us have drawn up our own indexes to the contents of the various magazines. I would hope that a club member would agree to maintain an "official" index, which would be regularly drawn to others' attention in the same way that Norman Batho's stamp checklist is (on the front cover of *Bicycle Stamps*), with a note of those members willing to provide at cost photocopies of a particular article. Alternatively these details could be offered to new members on joining, and from time to time they should be sent to major philatelic libraries.

Collectors who lose interest may like to offer any substantial "run" of unwanted copies to the club or appropriate philatelic libraries, or advertise them in *Bicycle Stamps*.

The Internet helps the international exchange of "archive" information, but I suspect not enough of us use it yet. In the meantime there remains the problem of ensuring that original material is assembled and preserved – though perhaps some members will reassure me that they have pristine sets of the magazines and have taken steps to ensure they will be available to future generations.

These thoughts are prompted by my spending a great deal of time collecting together scattered information on non-cycling subjects for my own interest. How frustrating it is when a complete set of an old publication doesn't exist or, if it does, it isn't indexed and one has to spend hours looking for an article that may or may not exist on a particular topic. The result of my labours is not usually commercially publishable and I have to think very hard about how best to ensure my work is not lost to others. So I hope that we will ensure that tomorrow's cyclist-philatelists will be able to benefit from the information that is readily available to us today.

### Editor's note:

The Club has always supplied copies of the magazine to the ATA and the BTA and one would assume they keep them on file! As to an index; due to the impossible task of remembering all previous articles, I compiled an index (see BS20A page 24) after Carl Wiedman sent me his for my comments. Mine only details information from *Spoken Word* and *Bicycle Stamps* and does not include any details for *Cycle Clips*. This was due to the fact that *Cycle Clips* and *Bicycle Stamps* were being produced during the same period and my list was only created to indicate (to me) that prior information had been made available through this Club's magazines. My list could be updated to include information regarding articles, etc. in *Cycle Clips* and made available to members. Questions:

1. Are any members interested in purchasing such a list?
2. Should *Cycle Clips* information be added to it?

Terry raises some interesting issues in his article and members comments on the matters raised would be welcomed.

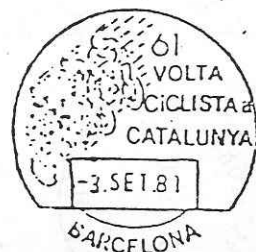
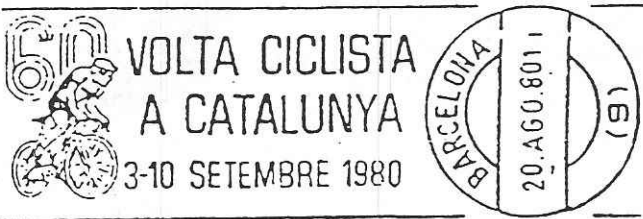
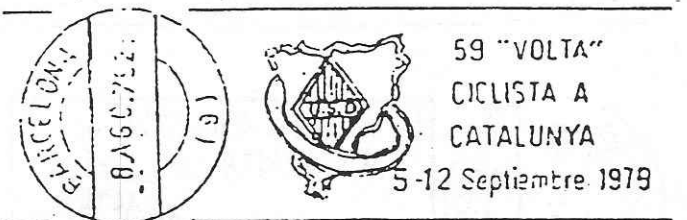
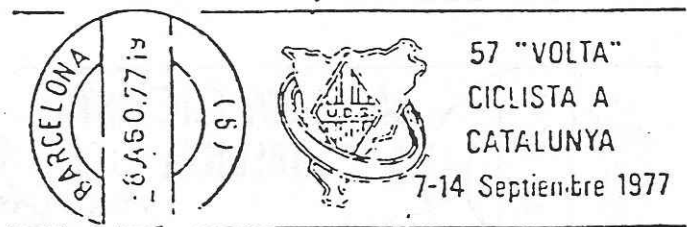
