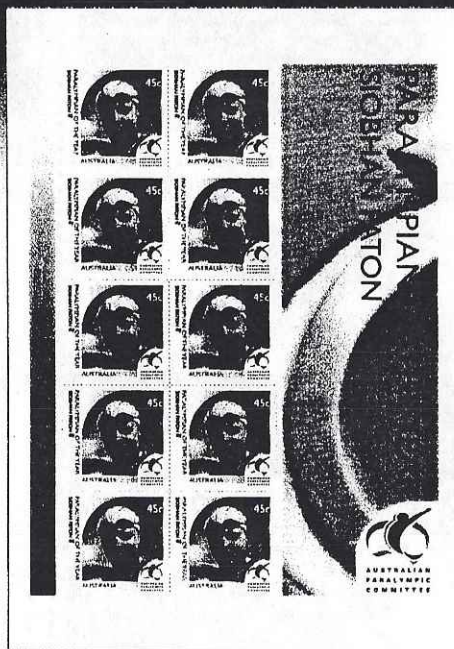
The award for the Paralympian of the Year was presented to Siobhan Paton by the Australian Paralympic Committee on the evening of 30 October at the Australian Paralympic Committee's Paralympian of the Year Dinner.

The process used computer-to-plate technology and the stamps were printed using five colour offset.

El ciclismo, uno de los deportes más difundidos en Europa, es otra de las modalidades deportivas que, junto al fútbol, cuentan con mayor afición en España. Es por ello que merece estar representado en un acontecimiento internacional tan relevante como la Exposición Mundial de Filatelia España 2000, acto con el que se celebra el 150 aniversario del primer sello español. Más aún cuando en nuestro país venimos contando con excelentes ciclistas de la categoría de Miguel Induráin, deportista ratificado como uno de los mejores corredores del mundo. De ahí que el ciclismo como deporte e Induráin, su rey, pasen, por popularidad y logros, a estar representados en la muestra y en la hojas bloque, sello y documentos filatélicos que ahora la conmemoran.

El ciclista navarro, Miguel Induráin Larraya, desde sus comienzos no defraudó a nadie, dio el perfil del auténtico ciclista entrenado para ganar. Su punto de partida fue aquel primer Campeonato de España (aficionado) celebrado en 1983, que ganó cuando tan sólo contaba con 19 años y que abriría el paréntesis a una dorada trayectoria, cerrado con su retiro del ciclismo profesional en 1996. En los trece años de duración de su vertiginosa carrera contabilizamos en su brillante palmarés: su liderazgo en las cuatro etapas de la Vuelta a España (1985);

Además de ser campeón de España (1992), un año después (1993) logró la medalla de plata en el campeonato del mundo de ciclismo de fondo en carretera; también se proclamó campeón mundial en la prueba contrarreloj, subcampeón en carretera (1995) y ganó la medalla de oro contrarreloj en los Juegos Olímpicos de Atlanta (1996). Induráin, por la relevancia de sus éxitos deportivos, se erige en el corredor más importante en la historia del ciclismo español.

EXPOSITION MONDIALE DE PHILATÉLIE ESPAÑA 2000 SPORTS: INDURÁIN

Le cyclisme, l'un des sports les plus diffusés en Europe, est une des nombreuses modalités sportives, avec le football, pour lesquelles les gens s'intéressent beaucoup en Espagne. C'est pourquoi il mérite bien d'être représenté dans un événement international aussi important que l'Exposition mondiale de Philatélie España 2000, qui fête le 150e anniversaire du premier timbre espagnol. Et ceci d'autant plus que l'Espagne a d'excellents cyclistes de la classe de Miguel Induráin, sportif qui a été reconnu comme l'un des meilleurs coureurs du monde. C'est pourquoi le cyclisme en tant que sport et Induráin, son roi, sont représentés, dû à leur popularité et à leurs succès, dans cette exposition et figurent sur les feuilles blocs, le timbre et les documents philatéliques qui la commémorent maintenant.

Depuis ses débuts, le cycliste navarrais, Miguel Induráin Larraya, n'a déçu personne, il fut l'authentique cycliste entraîné pour gagner. Son point de départ fut ce premier Championnat d'Espagne (amateur) qui eut lieu en 1983, qu'il gagna alors qu'il n'avait que 19 ans et qui allait être le début d'une carrière en or, à laquelle sa retraite du cyclisme professionnel mit fin en 1996. Pendant les treize ans que cette vertigineuse carrière a duré, nombreux ont été les trophées : il a gagné quatre étapes du Tour d'Espagne en 1985, il a triomphé au Tour de l'Avenir en 1986, il a été cinq fois de suite vainqueur au Tour de France (de 1991 à 1995) et deux fois au Tour d'Italie en 1992 et en 1993. En dehors du fait d'être champion d'Espagne en 1992, un an après, en 1993, il a obtenu la médai-

lle d'argent au championnat du monde de cyclisme de fond sur route. Il a aussi été proclamé champion mondial de l'épreuve contre la montre, sous-champion sur route en 1995 et a remporté la médaille d'or de course contre la montre aux Jeux olympiques d'Atlanta en 1996. Induráin, en raison de l'importance de ses succès sportifs, est le coureur le plus important de l'histoire du cyclisme espagnol.

SPAIN 2000 WORLD PHILATELY EXHIBITION SPORTS: INDURÁIN

Cycling is one of Europe's most popular sports and, together with football, it is another form of sport that enjoys a large number of fans in Spain. For this reason it deserves to be represented at such an important international occurrence as the Spain 2000 World Philately Exhibition, an event that celebrates the 150th anniversary of the issuing of the first Spanish postage stamp. And even more so given that our country has turned out excellent cyclists of the category of Miguel Induráin, a sportsman confirmed as one of the best racers in the world. This is why, cycling as a sport, and Induráin, its King, are, due to their popularity and achievements, to be represented at the exhibition and on the block sheets, stamp and philatelic documents that commemorate it.

Navarra-born cyclist Miguel Induráin Larraya, never a let-down to anyone right from the very start, gave the profile of the genuine cyclist trained to win. His starting point was that first Championship of Spain (Amateur), held in 1983, which he won at the age of just 19 years, and which would open the path to a golden career, which came to an end with his retirement from professional cycling in 1996. The thirteen years of his vertiginous career have left us able to count up in his brilliant track record: his leadership in the four stages of the Tour of Spain (1985); his triumph in the Tour del Porvenir (1986); five consecutive victories in the Tour de France (1991-1995) and two triumphs in the Tour of Italy (1992-1993). In addition to being proclaimed Spanish Champion (1992), a year later (1993) he won the silver medal in the Long Distance Road Cycling World Championship; he was also proclaimed World Champion in the time trials, Runner-up on the road (1995) and he won the time trial gold medal at the Olympic Games of Atlanta (1996). Induráin, due to the significance of his sporting successes, has become the most important cyclist in the history of Spanish cycling.

WELTAUSSTELLUNG FÜR PHILATELIE SPANIEN 2000 SPORT: INDURÁIN

Als einer der in Europa am meisten verbreiteten Sportarten gilt der Radsport auch in Spanien als die nach dem Fußball beliebteste Sportart. Aus diesem Grund erhält auch diese einen Ehrenplatz bei einem solch relevanten internationalen Ereignis wie der Weltausstellung für Philatelie Spanien 2000,

mit welcher das 150. Jubiläum der ersten spanischen Briefmarke gefeiert wird. Dies umso mehr, wo wir in unserem Land auf so hervorragende Radler der Kategorie von Miguel Induráin stolz sein können, einem Sportler, der ohne Zweifel zu den besten Radrennfahrern der Welt zu zählen ist. Daher erscheint der Radrennsport und Induráin als *König* dieser Sportart dank seiner Popularität und Erfolge auf diesem Markenblock, der Marke sowie den philatelistischen Begleitdokumenten, die zur Erinnerung an diese Ausstellung herausgegeben werden.

Der Radrennfahrer Miguel Induráin Larraya aus Pamplona hat von Anfang an niemanden enttäuscht, indem er sich stets dem Profil eines wirklich zum Siegen trainierten Sportlers würdig zeigte. Als Anfangspunkt seiner Karriere gilt jene Spanische Meisterschaft (der Amateure) von 1983, die er im Alter von nur 19 Jahren gewann und welche die Führungspunkte zu seiner pfeilförmigen Erfolgskurve setzen sollte, die erst mit seinem freiwilligen Ausscheiden aus dem professionellen Radsport im Jahre 1996 endete. In diesen bloß drei Jahren schwindelerregender Karriere kann er auf eine brillante Trophäensammlung zurückschauen: der erste Platz in den vier Etappen der *Vuelta a España* (1985); sein Triumph in der *Tour del Porvenir* (1986); die fünf aufeinander folgenden Siege der *Tour de Francia* (1991-1995) sowie die beiden Siege im *Giro de Italia* (1992-1993). Abgesehen von der spanischen Meisterschaft (1992) holte er sich ein Jahr später (1993) die Silbermedaille in der Weltmeisterschaft des Straßen-Langstreckenradrennens; auch der Titel als Weltmeister im Zeitrennen blieb ihm nicht verwehrt. Schließlich noch wurde er zweiter Sieger im Straßenrennen (1995) und gewann die Goldmedaille im Zeitrennen bei den Olympischen Spielen von Atlanta (1996). 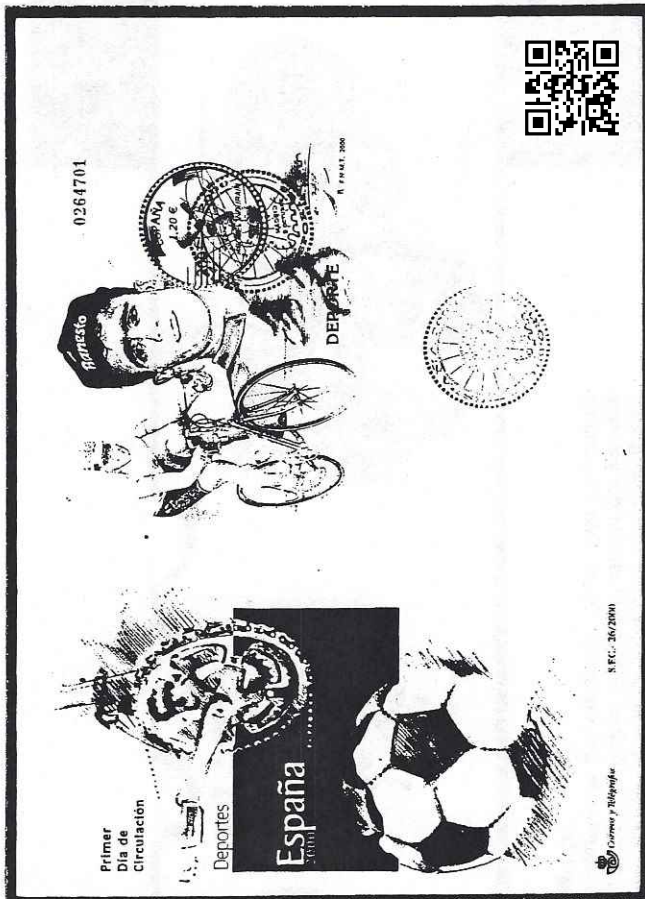
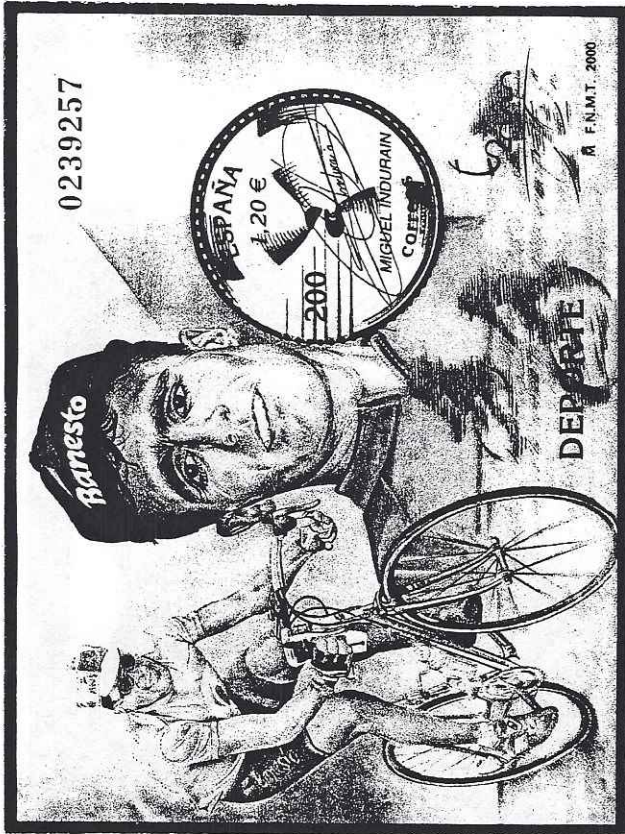
