VALE - RON SANT

It is with deepest regret that I have to inform you all of the passing of Ron, who died of a heart attack in September.

Ron was a founder member of the Club, and he became the UK Treasurer in December 1994 and continued in this role until the end of 2001.

Ron was very active in the field of bicycle history and was a member of the Veterans' Cycling Club and The Fellowship of Cycling Old-Timers (FCOT). He was also the President of his local cycling club for many years.

He toured extensively and when I met him in July 1997 he had not long returned from a tour of Spain; there were 200 riders - 199 on high-wheelers and Ron on a shaft-driven ordinary. Some years ago he was a member of a group of riders who rode from Paris to Prague on their high-wheelers.

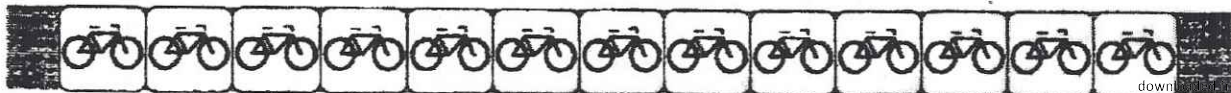
During my visit he showed me around his workshops - he had purchased nine garages, built in three rows of three, with two rows back-to-back, enclosed in a yard with a strong gate and quite high stone wall. In one row he had knocked down the internal walls to form one big garage where he housed his collection of 60 bikes, tandems, 30 mugs, various cycling posters, plastic bags with cycling logos, key-rings (hanging on a bike-related hanger) all cycling related.

The other six garages were his workshops. He was a skilled engineer and very methodical. I.e: workshop #1 was his "dirty shop", containing a lathe, drill, power saw, etc. #2 was storage and #3 the paint shop, etc.

He not only owned an original high-wheeler but a modern replica. When I asked him why have both, he said: "When you're learning to ride one you fall off a lot and it's better you don't damage your original high wheeler". He then took the replica out into the street, mounted and rode up and down to demonstrate his skill.

In 1997 he was still actively riding, training regularly on the Manchester Velodrome. With a mate he held four tandem trike records (on the road), 12hr, 24hr, etc.


It was my pleasure to have known Ron personally and I hope all members will join me in expressing our sincere condolences to his mother Janet and his family. He will be sorely missed by everyone.

JUNO BEACH : c'est la plage attribuée à la 3ème division Canadienne d'infanterie, commandée par le Major Général Keller, pour y débarquer le matin du 6 juin 1944 à 7h55 avec 20 minutes de retard sur les prévisions, à cause d'une mer mauvaise. Plage de 7Km de long, comprenant les villages de Graille-sur-Mer, Courseulles-sur-Mer, Bernière-sur-Mer et Saint-Aubin-sur-Mer. Ce secteur était compris entre les plages britanniques de Gold et de Sword. Ce fut un débarquement de 24 000 combattants (15 000 Canadiens et 9 000 Britanniques) Les villages du secteur de Juno furent libérés entre 9h30 et 11h30. De nombreuses pertes en matériel et en hommes : 304 tués, 574 blessés, 74 prisonniers.

- De nombreuses photographies prises par les reporters militaires attestent de ces événements. Sur les clichés pris dans les embarcations lors de la traversée et sur les plages de Juno, on est surpris par le nombre incroyable de bicyclettes embarquées. Les bicyclettes et aussi des petites motocyclettes pliantes étaient censées accélérer l'avance de l'infanterie pour neutraliser l'aéroport de Carpiquet près de Caen et d'effectuer une jonction avec les Britanniques de Gold et de Sword.

- A l'occasion des 50 ème et 60 ème Anniversaires du Débarquement en Normandie, des administrations postales ont émis des séries de cartes de téléphone et des séries de timbres largement inspirées des documents photographiques de cette époque.



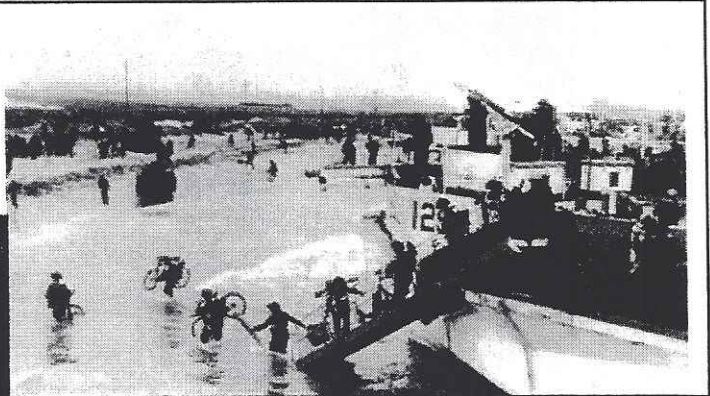

Tom Turbo ist eine der beliebtesten Kinderserien im ORF. In vielen Folgen ist das beliebte, turbotolle Fahrrad Tom Turbo mit Thomas Brezina im Einsatz und gemeinsam klären die beiden die kniffligsten Fälle und bringen die Missetäter zur Strecke. Unterstützt werden sie von 6 Kindern: Florentina, Johanna, Yvonne, Daniel, Jeriko und Simon helfen den Meisterdetektiven! Natürlich können auch die Kinder zu Hause an den Fernsehgeräten bei der Jagd nach den Gaunern miträteln, um das streng geheime Codewort zu erraten und mit etwas Glück als Meisterdetektiv ausgezeichnet zu werden.

2003 gab es einen Zeichenwettbewerb der Österreichischen Post AG gemeinsam mit ORF Confetti Tivi. Die Kinder konnten auf einer Vorlage „Das spannendste Abenteuer mit Tom Turbo“ zeichnen und malen. Die Zahl der Einsendungen und vor allem die Kreativität der Bilder waren überwältigend. Die Jury, gemeinsam mit Thomas Brezina, hatte es nicht leicht, aus den liebevoll gezeichneten Abenteuern des cleveren Fahrrades mit den großen Augen das Bild auszuwählen, das auf einer Sondermarke die größte Wirkung erzielt. Aber es gab nach langem Ringen einen Sieger: eine der Zeichnungen von Andreas Wolkerstorfer (7 Jahre alt) aus Garsten wurde ausgewählt und als Sondermarke gedruckt. Der dazupassende Sonderstempel wurde nach der Zeichnung von Fabian Rigler (6 Jahre) gestaltet.

Tom Turbo® children's drawing

Tom Turbo is one of the favourite children's series on Austrian television. Popular turbo-powered bicycle Tom Turbo has appeared in many series with the author Thomas Brezina, and together they have solved the most difficult cases and brought offenders to justice. The detectives are assisted by six children, Florentine, Johanna, Yvonne, Daniel, Jeriko and Simon. Of course, children at home in front of their TV sets can also join in the search for the crooks by working out the top secret code word and, with a little luck, they can win the title of Master Detective.

In 2003, a drawing competition was held by the Austrian Post together with the ORF Confetti Tivi programme. The children were invited to draw and paint on the topic of "the most exciting adventure with Tom Turbo®". The number of entries and above all the creativity of the pictures was amazing. The jury, together with Thomas Brezina, had a difficult job selecting, from amongst the lovingly drawn adventures of the clever bicycle with the large eyes, the picture that would have the greatest effect on a commemorative stamp. However, after a long discussion, the winner was chosen: one of the drawings by Andreas Wolkerstorfer (7 years old) from Garsten was selected and printed as a commemorative stamp. The corresponding special postmark was designed on the basis of a drawing by Fabian Rigler (6 years old).

Le tampon spécial qui accompagne le timbre a été conçu d'après un dessin de Fabian Rigler âgé de 6 ans.

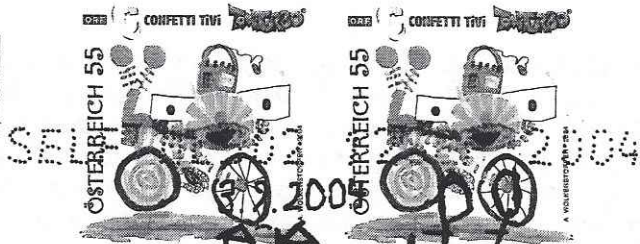
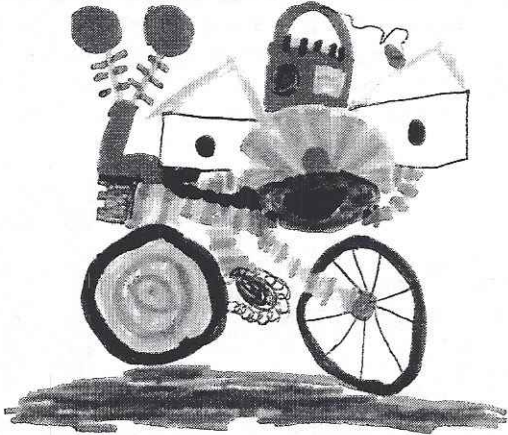

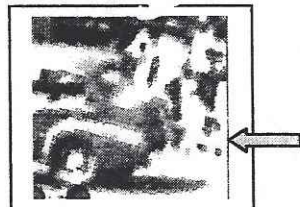
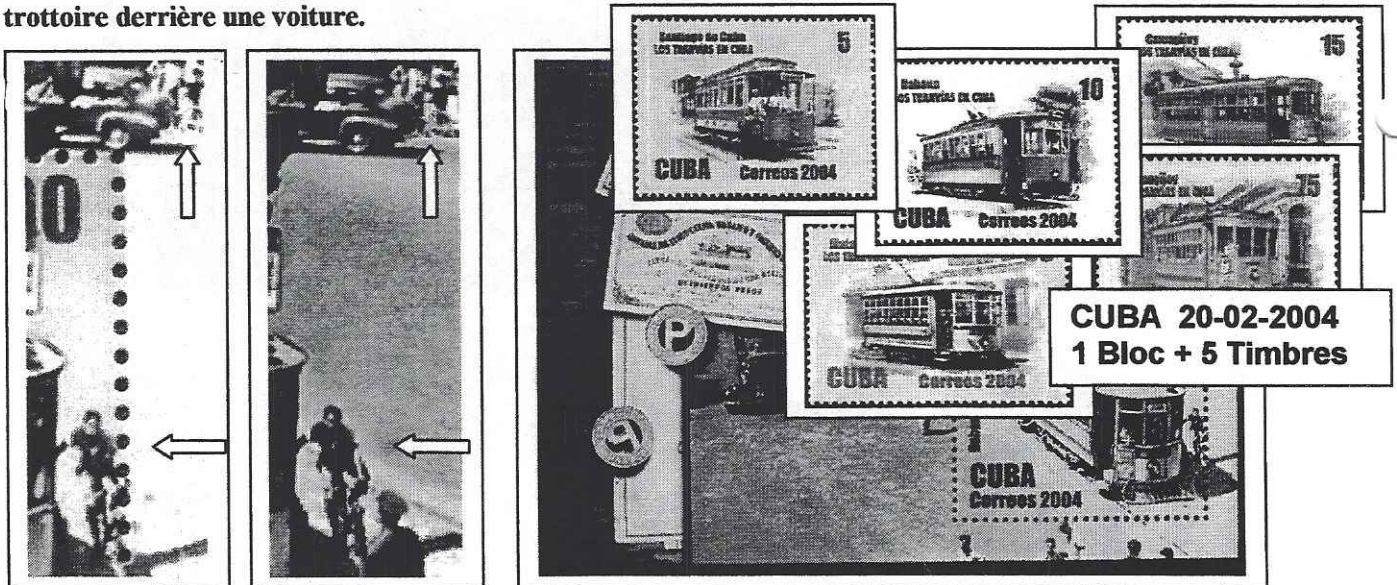
On 20 February 2004 Correos de Cuba (Post Office of Cuba) issued a series of postage stamps commemorating Cuba's tramway heritage. All the tram images on the stamps were copied from The Tramways of Cuba, the website by Allen Morrison, in violation of international copyright, without consulting him and without giving credit either to him or to the photographers and collectors involved. Black & white pictures were colorized. All images were altered slightly in an obvious attempt at disguise. The illustrations below compare the stamps with the original photographs on which they were based.

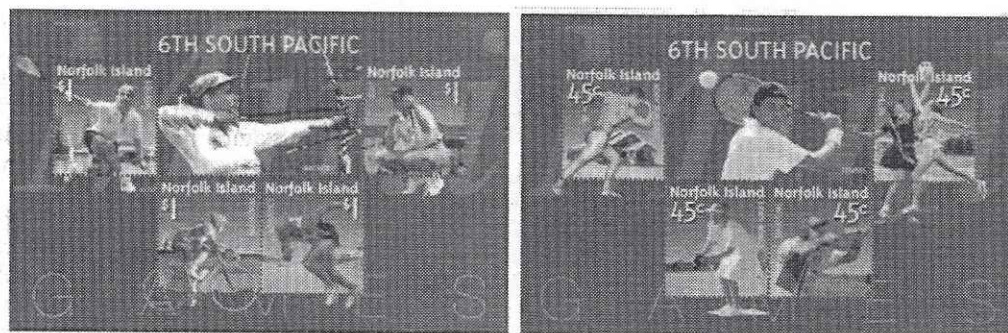

NORFOLK SHEETS SOLD AFTER PRINT STUFF-UP

An undisclosed number of Norfolk Island Postal Service sheetlets that were withdrawn from sale after a quality-control "stuff-up" have, accidentally ended up on the market, according to the Norfolk Island Postal Service (NIPS).

The two sheetlets were scheduled for release as part of the Commemorative issue for the 6th South Pacific Games.



Industry sources told Stamp News that 300 sets were thought to have been released before the issue was withdrawn. These were sold by the Crown Agents in London before it was decided to pull them off the market because NIPS felt the issue was seriously flawed.

Incorrect artwork being laid up at the printers was cited as the origin of the problem, compounded by a "mea culpa" admission from NIPS of failure to detect the error at proofing stage, because the full QC proofing procedure was not correctly followed.

NIPS, says the result was "totally unacceptable" and withdrew the issue, but not before the limited sales occurred.

Of those sold, it is known that a quantity was sold to a dealer in the US. No Australian dealers are known to have made direct purchases, although Stamp News understands Max Stern has since acquired two sets from a Florida dealer, presumably the original US purchaser. Current market value is probably around US\$ 2000 for the pair, but Max Stern may hang on to this unusual issue - at least until the smoke clears and values settle.

Editor's note: The sheetlets were certainly planned as this extract from Stanley Gibbons New Issues and Topicals website clearly shows:

"These Games were held for the first time on Norfolk Island in December, with approximately 1,000 athletes plus supporters participating. The island was bursting at the seams to accommodate them all. There were 10 events and these are featured in two Souvenir Sheets and 2 stamps. The events are Triathlon, Netball, Bodybuilding, Clay Target Shooting, Squash, Lawn Bowls, Tennis, Golf, Archery and Athletics. The sheets are designed by Glenn Douran and the single stamps by Tracey Yager and Photopress International".

There are noticeable similarities between four of the stamps on the sheetlets and the Norfolk Island Commonwealth issue. These are the stamps in question:

Six cards this month and all from England, for which I make no apology! Four of them given to me by my mother on her return to Australia recently from holiday in Norfolk and Cambridgeshire where I spent my early years. All of these cards are unused.

Fig. 1 (above) is a real photograph of West Field Road in Manea, Cambridgeshire during Edwardian times, and this card was produced by E.M. Softly Post Office, Manea. Softly must have had some sway with the locals, as the kids and their bikes are out in force! Manea was at that time a very small village farming community and is part of the Fenland area. Agriculture was quite lucrative in those days, and many children were able to have the luxury of bicycles! This card was printed in Saxony. Value about \$25

Fig. 2 (below) is another view of Manea, this time of The Green and again photograph by E.M. Softly. This one is not real

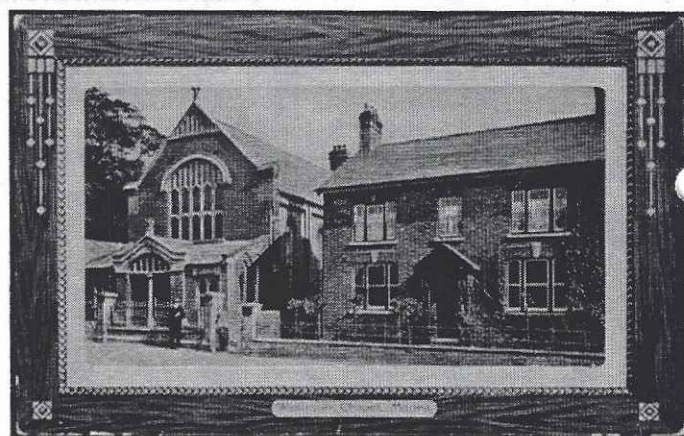


Fig 3 (above) is of the same vintage as fig 1 and shows the Wesleyan Chapel. Now cards of churches are not particularly sought after or valuable, however the figure leaning against the church railings is in fact my Great Grandfather, William Wright who was actually a lay preacher at the chapel. Value around \$5



Fig. 4 (above). William Wright & his three sons, my Grandfather included all played in the Manea Silver Band, and this real photographic card is of the band in the 1930's leading the parade at the Manea Feast. Again note the later period of the dress. The shop to the left of the picture is the Peterborough & District Co-operative Society, who were the major suppliers of groceries to the area. This card is by Alice Askew of March, Cambridgeshire. Unusual to have a female photographer in this era. Nice card and worth about \$25.
