

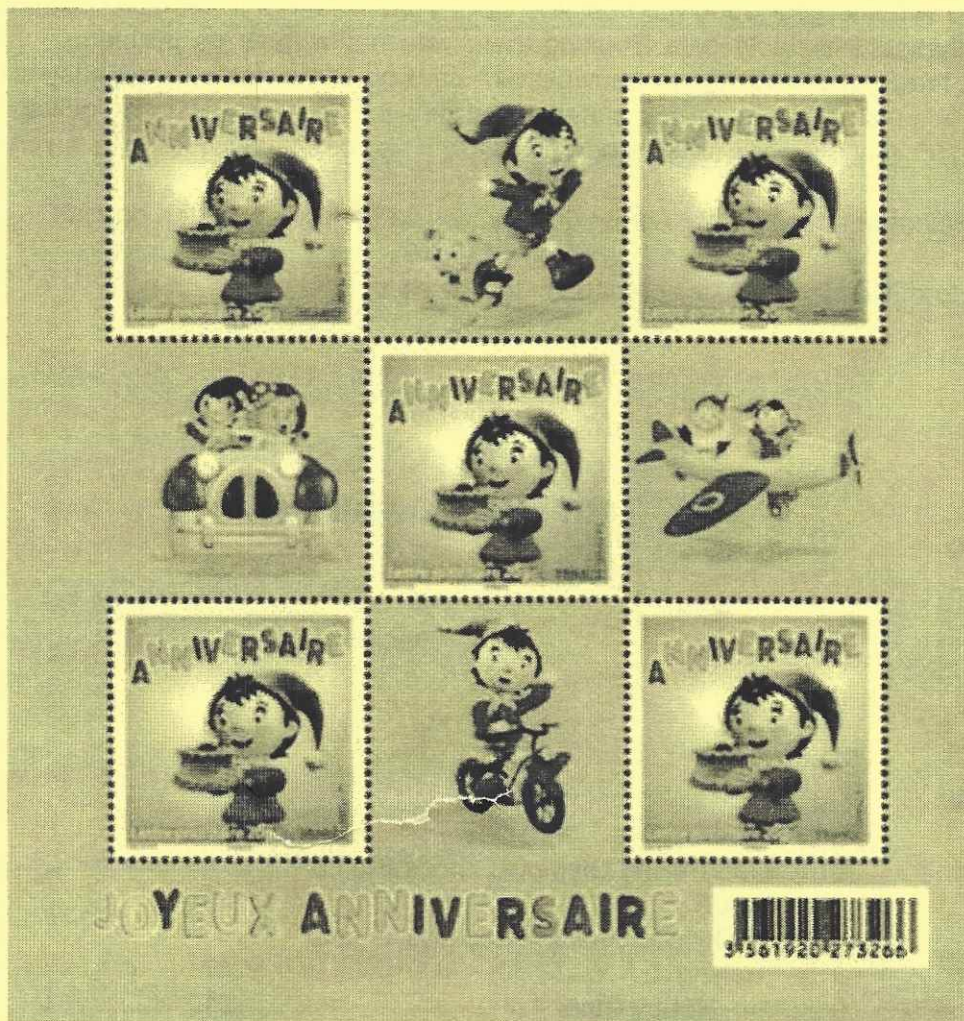

BEIJING 2008 OLYMPIC GAMES
1 AUGUST 2008

This commemorative stamp issue features three sports representative of Australia's participation at the Beijing Olympics. The stamps have been designed by Hobart-based graphic designer Lynda Warner. An auspicious number for the Chinese, the number eight has been incorporated into the design. The Games commence at 8p.m. on the eighth day of the eighth month of 2008.

Basketball

The Olympic basketball competition will be played in Beijing's Wukesong Indoor Stadium. Both the Australian women's team and men's team have qualified for the Beijing Olympics.

The Australian women's team made its first appearance in Los Angeles 1984 and has qualified for every Olympics since, except for Barcelona 1992. The bronze medal won by the women's team Atlanta in 1996 was the first Olympic medal for Australian basketball. In Sydney 2000 and Athens 2004 they improved their performances to gain silver, losing to the United States on both occasions.

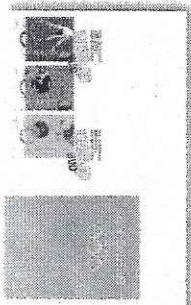
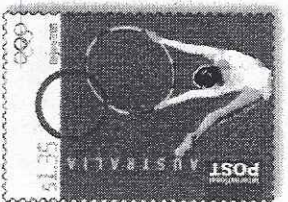
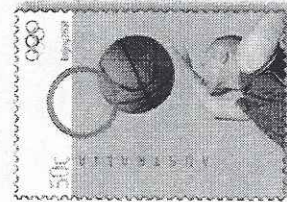
Australia's men first played in Melbourne 1956 and have qualified for every Olympics since with the exception of Rome 1960 and Mexico City 1968. The best finish for the men's team has been fourth in Seoul (1988), Barcelona (1992), and Sydney (2000).

Cycling

Cycling events have been present at every stage of the Modern Olympics since Athens 1896. Women's cycling was introduced in Los Angeles in 1984, mountain biking made its Olympic debut at Atlanta 1996 and BMX makes its first appearance in Beijing. The track, mountain bike and BMX events will all be held at Lacoshan in Beijing's west. The road races and time trials will be held arounds the streets of Beijing.

Australia has a long and proud tradition in Olympic cycling and, in terms of medals won per events contested, the sport is one of the most successful for this nation. With a record six gold medals, Athens 2004 was the most successful Olympics for Australian cycling. Ryan Bayley won the men's sprint and the keirin, becoming the first Australian to win two individual cycling gold medals. Other gold medals were awarded to Anna Meares with a world record time in the 500 metre time trial, Sara Carrigan in the women's road race, the all-conquering team pursuit squad, and Graeme Brown and Stuart O'Grady in the Madison.

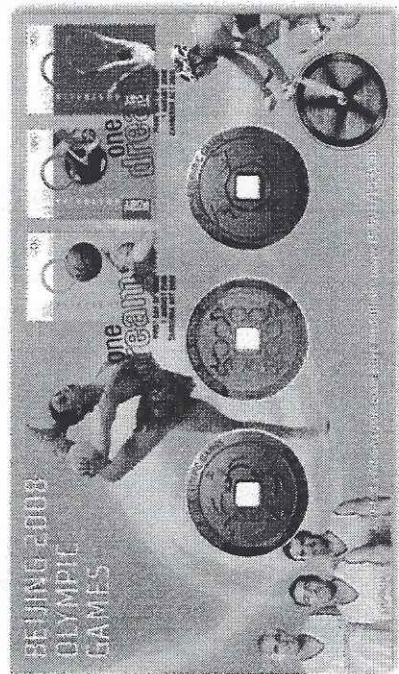

Gymnastics

Gymnastics appeared in the first Olympic Games of the modern era in Athens in 1896. The sport has been on the Olympic program ever since, with women first competing in Amsterdam 1928. The 1970s saw Olympic gymnastics, particularly for women, change from being a physical display to entertainment. Rhythmic gymnastics, which is for women only, was added in Los Angeles 1984 and trampolining debuted at Sydney 2000.

Australian gymnasts are looking to gain their first Olympic artistic medal in Beijing. The first Australian Olympic gymnasts competed in Melbourne in 1956. Australia has never won a medal in artistic or rhythmic gymnastics, with a best placing of seventh coming from the women's combined team at Barcelona 1992 and Sydney 2000. Ji Wallace received Australia's first medal in gymnastics when he came second in the men's trampoline in the sport's debut at the Sydney Games.

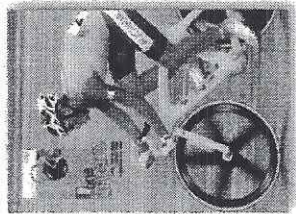
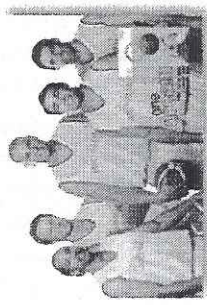

(BEIJING, November 2) -- Authorized by the Beijing Organizing Committee for the Games of the XXIX Olympiad (BOCOG), an Olympic-themed stamp scroll -- the longest of its kind -- was unveiled in Beijing on Friday.

The scroll, ratified by the China Post and issued by the Beijing Stamp Company, comprises images of the Olympic Emblem, mascot Fuwa, and 38 Olympic Pictograms as well as 128 characterized Olympic stamps.

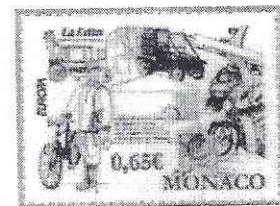
The scroll, at 6.33 meters, is the longest one in China's history, beating the previous record of 5.28 meters "held" by a memorial stamp-scroll for a famous painting called "Qingmingshanghetu."

The time was chosen with the greatest of care. The 29th Summer Olympics will be opened in Beijing on the evening of 8.08.2008 at 8.08 local time. The Chinese have always regarded eight – or “ba” in Mandarin – as a lucky number, possibly because the word resembles the concept of “fa” or wealth.

The Chinese capital asserted its bid to hold the Olympics against Istanbul, Osaka, Paris and Toronto. After Tokyo (1964) and Seoul (1988), this is only the third time that this top-flight international sporting event has been held in Asia, so Swiss Post is dedicating two stamps and a picture postcard to three Olympic disciplines in tribute to Beijing 2008.

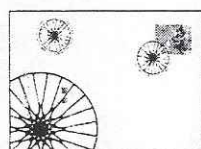

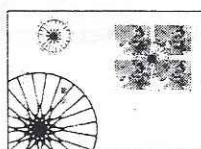

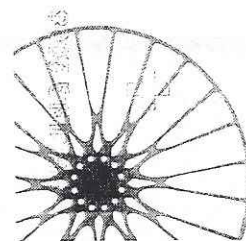
Swiss Post is issuing to mark the Beijing Summer Olympics:

■ **Mountainbike:** Mountainbiking – or MTB for short – is a comparatively recent Olympic sport and was first included among the Olympic disciplines at the 1996 Atlanta Games. MTB is becoming an increasingly popular participant sport. It can also be seen as a kind of decathlon on wheels. Agility and balancing skills play an important part, as do sliding, acceleration and quick reading of the terrain. Mountainbiking features on a CHF 1.00 special stamp.

■ **BMX:** The abbreviation BMX stands for "Bicycle Moto Cross". In this sport, dare-devil athletes ride courses with jumps and all kinds of obstacles on small bikes with 20-inch wheels. BMX was invented as a fun sport in the 1960s in California, but it was not until the 1980s that a wider public became aware of it when a BMX bike played an important part in Steven Spielberg's hit film "E.T.". The first World Championships were held in 1982, and BMX is making its debut as an Olympic discipline this summer in Beijing. The BMX stamp is an official IOC stamp and cannot be used to prepay items sent by private individuals.

Canoeing: a long-established Olympic sport

Canoeing has been part of Olympic history for many years – the hunt for medals in this discipline began as early as 1936 in Berlin. In China, this sport is rated much higher than either of the two bike disciplines mentioned above for the simple reason that, at the 2004 Summer Olympics in Athens, the two Chinese athletes Meng Guanliang and Yang Wenjun, took the gold medal in the men's C2 500 metre race. In contrast to BMX and MTB, people have been using canoes for thousands of years as a means of locomotion – for travel, fishing and hunting. So on the occasion of the Beijing Summer Olympics, canoeing stars on a picture postcard.

My introduction to stamp collecting began a long time ago, when there was a stamp shop in almost every town. It was easy to collect stamps from all over the world, provided that you had the money!

For a small boy such as me, collecting started at home with stamps culled from letters and postcards – especially those from my cousins in America. Mother also resurrected her wartime letters from my father and her brothers – a treasure trove of King George V early stamps. I now appreciate that they may have been better left on the envelopes, intact. Swaps were also a principal source of new stamps and the school stamp club was another.

Stamp albums were expensive and one usually had to wait for a birthday or Christmas. In the meantime, Woolworth's provided exercise books at 1d or 2d each. Until you learned better, the tendency was to stick the stamps in with flour and water paste, or worse – Gloy.

Woolworth's, the '3d and 6d Store', sold packets of stamps

When it comes to his favourite hobby, Alan Randall Jones has got it licked

packed by XLCR or Ace. These we thought were good value and most were quite common, mainly from the British Empire.

With my birthday came my first fixed-page album. This had a page per country and illustrations of stamps that never seemed to come my way. From an uncle, came a magnifying glass, a packet of hinges and 250 'All World, Mixed'. I spent many wet evenings and weekends transferring the

collection from the exercise book to the proper album, my mother overseeing and making sure that it was neat.

At this time I was preparing for my Collector proficiency badge in the Wolf Cubs: 'I did my best' and was successful. I was given a small booklet – the *XLCR Stamp Guide*, which is still published today and has proved an invaluable source of reference over the last seventy years. Every Sunday evening, the

stamps were counted and the totals entered in pencil on the album's back flyleaf.

I continued with my collecting when, in 1939, I was evacuated to Whaley Bridge in Derbyshire. My foster parents were childless and when I told them about my hobby, they dug out old letters from overseas and cut the stamps off for me. I now had stamps from Canada, France, Germany, and somewhere called Ceylon.

As I grew older and went to grammar school, I became more selective and restricted my scope to Great Britain, America and Persia. Why Persia? I had been introduced to the mysteries of the *Whitfield King of Ipswich Stamp Catalogue* and looking at all the countries, came to the conclusion that as the most expensive stamp of Persia was valued at £500, this was a figure that I could visualise as being within my reach when I grew older. Most of the other Persian stamps were only worth coppers, so I started my 'other' collection, which I still maintain.

I was a regular visitor to John Lea's stamp shop in Manchester. He was not afraid of schoolboys and kept special stock books of low-cost stamps. All he asked was that we behaved ourselves in the shop. The other Manchester shop

was Heywood's in the Old Shambles, but he was pricier and not greatly addicted to schoolboys.

Service in the Army during the war, followed by marriage, curbed my philatelic interest. When Lea's moved their stamp shop from Albert Square to King Street, I visited out of curiosity. This got me addicted again and I started taking the now defunct *Stamp Collecting Weekly* and sending away for covers to obtain interesting postmarks.

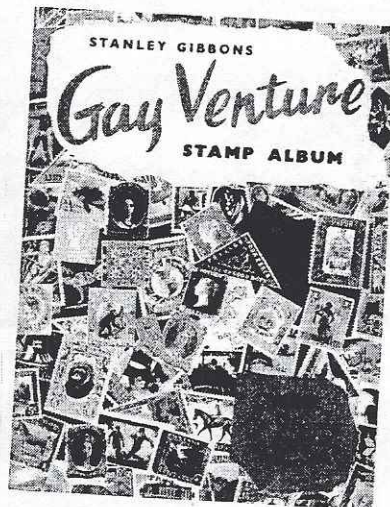
In 1969, my work took me to Norway, where we lived until 1974. My landlord, Franz Moldenhauer, was the only stamp dealer in Bergen – nothing but a coincidence – and my friend, an orchestral musician in the Bergen's Harmonium, induced me to become a member of the Bergen Filatelist Klubb. Here I met many knowledgeable collectors and with their help and enthusiasm entered club competitions and won my first medals.

Because my stamp collection was in storage, I had to start again. I began with the postmarks of Queen Victoria and King Edward VII, and also branched out with two themes. I was a fire protection engineer so I chose the subject of Fire Protection and Prevention.

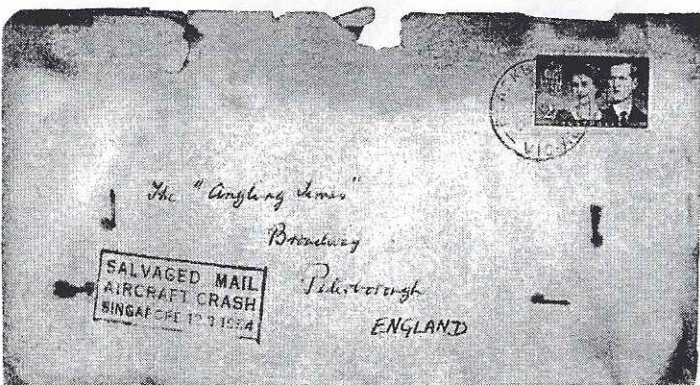
The other collection was influenced by the fact I had visited Denmark and Sweden on business and was fascinated by the story of

the Nobel Laureates. This contains so many sideline collections that it would be easy to be distracted and lose the thread. For example, the International Red Cross, Sir Winston Churchill, Albert Einstein, Marie Curie and the International Labour Organisation have all won Nobel Prizes and there is sufficient material for each one to be a stand alone collection. This collection now stands at about 200 pages and is still growing.


Returning to the UK, I decided to join a stamp club and chose Boston Philatelic Society, which I consider the best in the country: on two occasions I have been honoured to have been its president. As the number of stamp shops has decreased, exchange packets and club auctions are now the most effective way of obtaining new material. There are also the London stamp fairs - Stampex, Philatelic and Thematica.

An additional bonus is the

friendships I have made all over Britain. More and more people are now collecting items of postal history and many are diverting into postcards. But Royal Mail is not helping the hobby, as much of today's mail is franked with a rubber stamp or sticky label. Another development is the computer-generated Smart stamp, allowing you, under licence, to print 'stamps' from a computer.

The final blow to the collector is, however, the ubiquitous e-mail, which does not require a stamp at all.

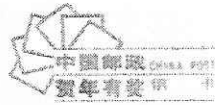

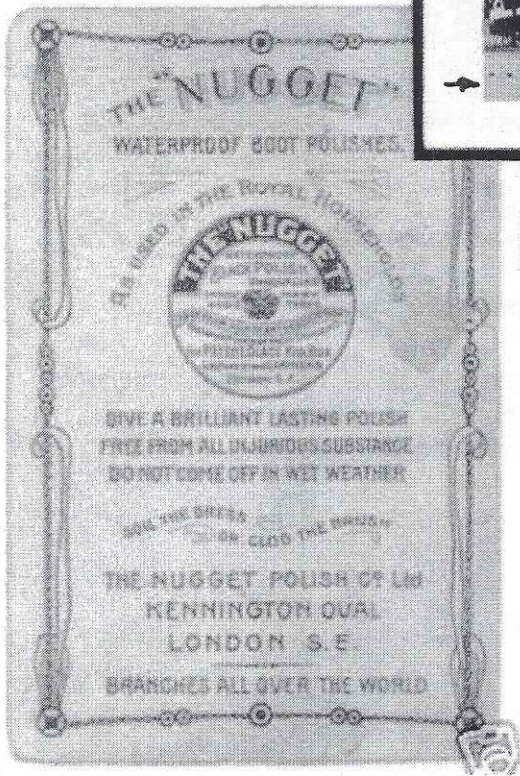
