

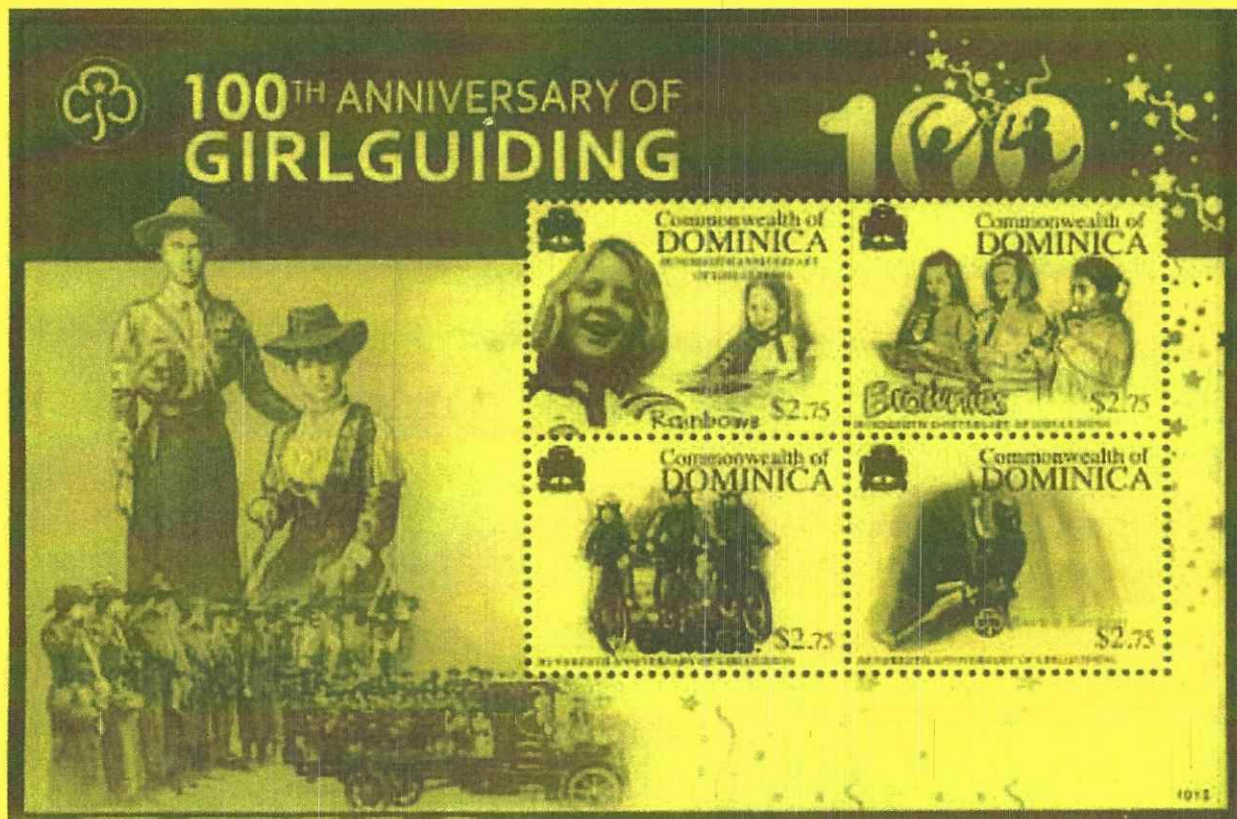

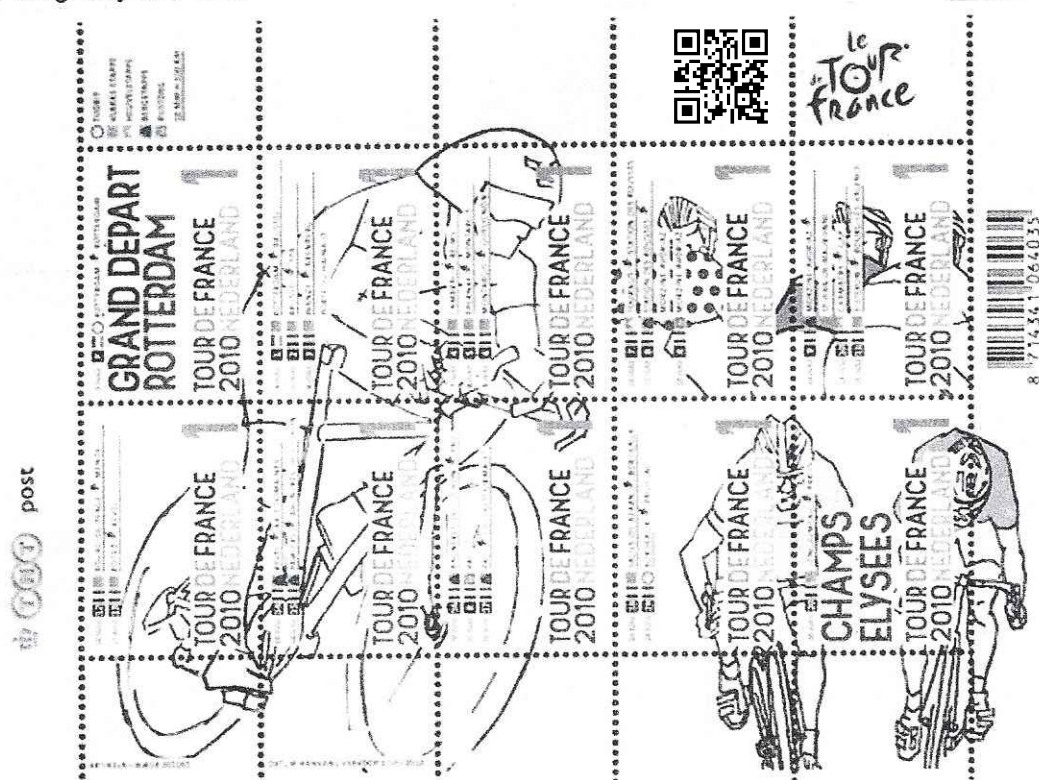

NETHERLANDS - 2010 TOUR de France

Tour de France hits Rotterdam

On 3 July 2010, the Dutch port of Rotterdam hosted the start of the Tour de France, the world's most significant, demanding and prestigious cycling event. The strongest cyclists around will face the ultimate challenge of covering 3,600 kilometres in twenty formidable stages. Saturday 3 July sees the thrilling prologue, with the cyclists hurtling their way around Rotterdam, including such sights as the Erasmus Bridge. Who will be fastest across the line in the south of the city in this 8-kilometre time trial? A big name like Lance Armstrong or Alberto Contador, or maybe even a Dutch cyclist? Whoever wins will have the honour of wearing the yellow jersey in the first stage, which also kicks off in Rotterdam. After touring the city, the race will continue via the Dutch towns of Spijkenisse, Hellevoetsluis and Goes on its way to Belgium. These initial flat stages will later be followed by hilly and mountainous areas, including the gruelling rides through the high Alps and Pyrenees. The long, individual time trial is also an illustrious part of the race. After more than three weeks of cycling, rounded off on the Champs-Élysées in Paris, the winner of the 97th Tour de France will step up onto the victory podium to accept his prize. The greatest reward is being able to join the distinguished company of those who have won the race, the first of which was held in 1903. But this point is still a speck on the horizon because, as the familiar cyclist saying goes, "it's a long way to Paris!"

Even more allure is being added to the 2010 Tour de France in the form of a special Tour de France stamp sheetlet featuring ten unique stamps. TNT Post will also be issuing a stamp presentation pack and first-day cover. A special aspect of these stamps is that they bear the new value indication. From now on stamps will no longer feature a price in euros but instead a number. A "1" will be used on stamps for letters and cards up to 20 grams, as is the case on the Tour de France stamps. The new value indication will not affect new stamp designs being issued. The stamp sheetlet costs €4.40.

Unique design language

The Tour de France is a world in its own right, with the teams and their tactics, the cyclists playing different roles, the leaders of the classifications each wearing a special jersey, the route with its start and finish points and the various kinds of stages. "We have incorporated many aspects of the Tour de France into the stamp sheetlet," says Bau Winkel, who designed the stamps together with his colleague Frank Stienen at Studio Bau Winkel. "In doing so we depicted the different symbols used in the race, such as the polka dot jersey, but applied our own design language."

Stage schedule

The block formed by the ten stamps shows the Tour de France's stage schedule. The stamp in the top left-hand corner is dedicated to the prologue, part of the *Grand Départ* in Rotterdam. On a single line, in each case we see the date of the stage, the order, the national flag of the country in which that stage starts, the symbol denoting the type of stage and the start and finish points. Below is a red line showing the comparative length of the stage, with 10mm on the stamps representing 100km of the route.

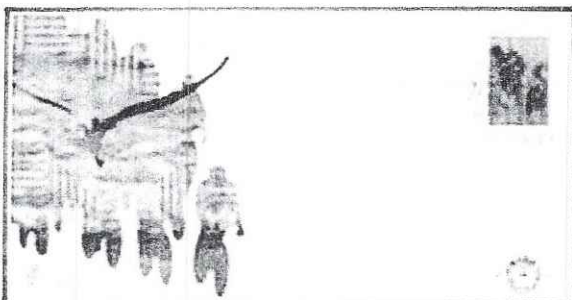
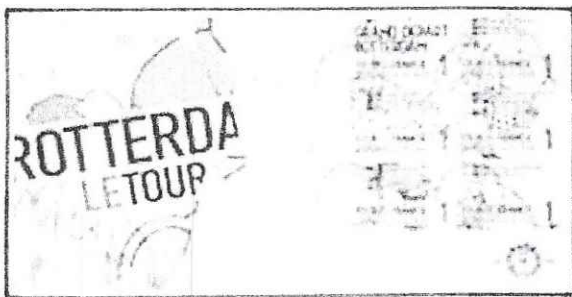
Fast-paced illustrations

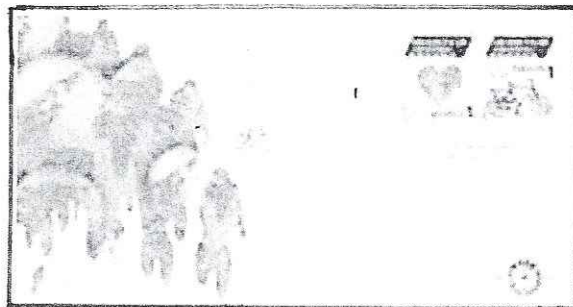
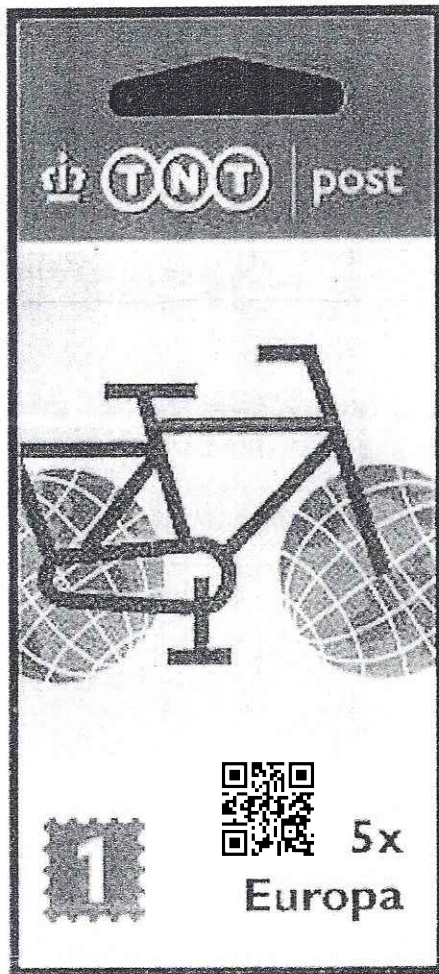
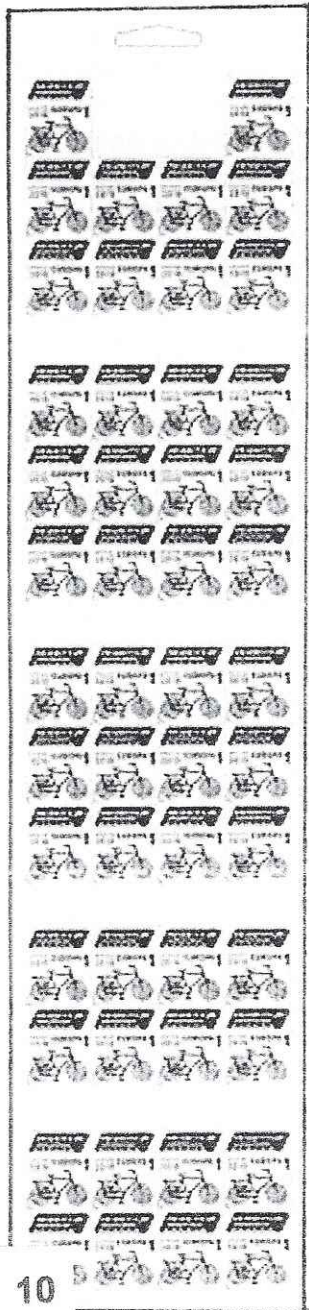
"The information on the various stages of the race is given using clear, modern typography in combination with images," says Frank Stienen. These stand-alone images extend beyond the limits of the stamps themselves, creating a feeling of tempo. On the left we see a cyclist dashing past during a time trial wearing an aerodynamic helmet. At the top right is part of the peloton, including the cyclist in the polka dot jersey, known as the "King of the Mountains" after being the fastest to reach the top. Below are two cyclists engaging in a sprint: the yellow and green jersey wearers indicating that they are the leader of the general classification and the leader in the points competition respectively.

Yellow: the ultimate goal

The stamps are framed by a bright yellow margin. "That's what it's all about after all," says Bau Winkel. "The yellow of the yellow jersey is the cyclists' ultimate goal." Frank Stienen adds: "What's more, the yellow contrasts well with the other colours, inspired by the red, white and blue of the French and Dutch flags. The word 'Nederland' is very appropriately printed in TNT orange. The colours are bright ones, representing what you see as the caravan sweeps past sporting a wide variety of racing colours worn by the 180 cyclists, who all left Rotterdam with their sights set on the same goal, the finishing line in Paris."

Stamp tribute to cyclist Nicolas Frantz

The Luxembourg racing cyclist Nicolas Frantz was born on 4 November 1899 in Mamer. In the course of his 12-years professional career (1923 to 1934) he got 60 victories.

In 1924, he placed second in the Tour de France and he was fourth the following year. In 1926 he was second once again, 1 hr 22 min 25 sec behind Belgian Lucien Buysse.

In 1927, Nicolas Frantz achieved immortality, beating the Belgian Maurice Dewaele by 1 hr 22 min 25 sec.



One year later, he won the Grande Boucle once again, this time by 50 min 7 sec over André Leducq. In 1929, Nicolas Frantz took fifth place in the Tour de France and won two stages. Frantz won Paris-Brussels in 1927 and Paris-Tours in 1929. He twice finished in the top three of the world championships.

Nicolas Frantz also won the Luxembourg championship for 12 consecutive years (from 1923 to 1934). He later became the Luxembourg sports manager in the Tour de France from 1949 to 1957. Nicolas Frantz was the sports manager of Charly Gaul's first national team in the Tour de France. He died on 8 November 1985 in Mamer.

In 2006, the Albanian Postal Services were out of stamps valued 40 Lek (standard postage fee for letters shipped domestically in Albania). To fulfill this need, 15 different stock stamps from miscellaneous sets of years 1993 - 1995 were overprinted with a Glossy Black cancellation of the original value, and the new value "40 Lek" beside the cancellation. Due to an administrative overlook, the collectors, U.P.U., and stamp catalog issuers, were not notified of this edition, which was used normally at the time in the post offices throughout Albania. Because of this, the first edition is very rare among collectors.

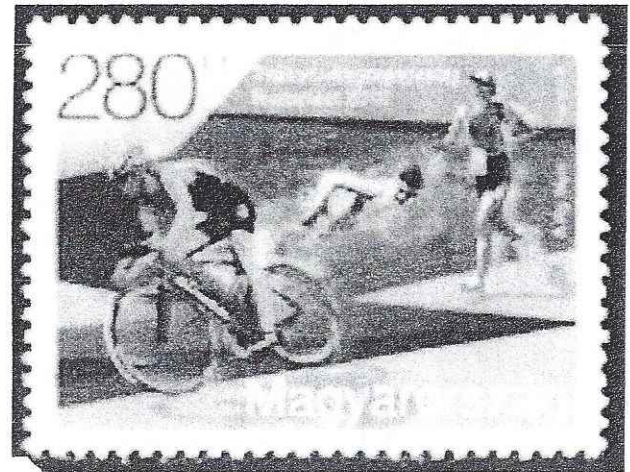
To fulfill the collectors needs, the Albanian Postal Services, issued in 2007 a partial rerun of 7 values from the original 15. This time the overprint used Matte Black ink. and is the more common variety.

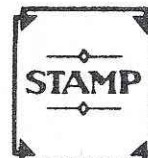
